ABIM has created a new MOC fee model that better aligns with the way you engage with our programs.

In 2022, ABIM will introduce a fee model that will enable board certified physicians to pay less to maintain certification than they do today. And, when your next assessment is due, the Longitudinal Knowledge Assessment (LKA") will be included at no additional charge.

Here's what you can expect to pay for MOC starting in 2022:

- 5% discount if paid prior to year it is due
- \$40 fee if paid in year after due

Traditional, 10-year MOC Exam



- In addition to the annual MOC fee
- Taken in a test center and paid when you register
- Waived if the LKA is not developed in your specialty*

Examples of savings for physicians choosing the LKA over a 10-year period**

	MOC FEES	SAVINGS***
Internal medicine physician with one certificate	\$2,200	\$100
Subspecialist with one certificate	\$2,200	\$650
Internal medicine physician also maintaining a subspecialty certificate	\$3,400	\$100
Physician with two subspecialty certificates	\$3,400	\$650

The new payment model will go into effect 1/1/22, and you can pay your 2022 certificate fee early and receive a 5% discount 12/1/21 – 12/31/21. Program fees for 2021 can be paid until 12/31/21 at the regular rate, without incurring late charges.
