<sup>(3)</sup> Because Knowledge Check-In exams are given every other year, starting from the year when the Knowledge Check-In is launched for a discipline, pass rates for the discipline are based on a rolling two year average that includes first-time takers for the Traditional exam and all takers for the Knowledge Check-In exam. For example, the 2018 pass rates for Internal Medicine and Nephrology are based on 2017 and 2018 takers. These pass rates are shaded in blue.
